### Post-Graduation Outcomes of the Class of 2014

**Abstract:** This report summarizes activities of the Class of 2014 during the 14-18 month period after graduating from Connecticut College. Data collected via the July 2015 One-Year-Out survey were supplemented with information obtained from other sources (National Student Clearinghouse, web searches, and CELS contacts). In total, information was found for 401 of the 468 graduates (86%). Of these 401, we have evidence that over 93% were either employed, enrolled in a degree program, completing a fellowship, or engaged in public service after graduation. Details of graduates' employment and educational experiences are also provided.

This report is divided into three parts. Results of the One-Year-Out survey are presented first. The second part combines information on post-graduation outcomes obtained from the survey (for those who responded) and other sources (for survey nonrespondents). Finally, the appendices present details of graduates' enrollment in degree programs and employment.

#### **ONE-YEAR-OUT SURVEY**

Each summer, the Office of Career-Enhancing Life Skills (CELS) and the Office of Institutional Research collaborate to administer an online "one-year-out" survey which ascertains the activities, particularly employment and graduate school enrollment, of members of the previous year's graduating class. On July 9, 2015, an email was sent to 468 graduates from the Class of 2014 inviting their participation in the One-Year-Out Survey. Of these 468 individuals, 196 (42%) completed at least the first survey question, and 178 (38%) persisted until the end. None of the survey items required—i.e., forced—a response, so there are some missing data.

The survey asked graduates to indicate one primary activity and any number of secondary activities they have engaged in since their May 2014 graduation. Results are presented in Table 1.

Nearly two-thirds of respondents said that their primary activity since graduation was full-time paid employment. Of course, graduates can be engaged in more than one of the activities listed in Table 1; 89 percent of respondents reported at least one additional, secondary activity. The right column of Table 1 displays the percent of survey respondents who reported each activity as *either* primary or secondary. Because each graduate can be represented in more than one activity, the right column does not sum to 100 percent.

As shown in Table 1, 72 percent of survey respondents said they had experienced some period of fultime paid employment since graduating, which implies that 7 percent of graduates had full-time employment during this period but did not consider it their "primary" activity. Roughly one quarter of respondents were engaged in a job search, part-time employment, travel, and/or graduate school preparation after graduation, although only a small percentage of graduates regarded any of these as their primary activity. Twenty-five percent of survey respondents were enrolled in some form of education, either a degree program or additional non-degree coursework. Details of the programs and institutions in which graduates enrolled are presented in Appendices A and B.

Respondents who said their primary and secondary activities after graduating included full-time employment, part-time employment, a fellowship, volunteer/service work, and/or an unpaid internship were asked for details and follow-up questions about the *first* position they held after graduating. Questions focused on the position's relevance to a graduate's college major(s), perception of how the position relates to his/her career, and how qualified he/she feels for the position. Table 2 shows overall results for respondents, as well as split out by whether their first position was reported as full-time or part-time.

Two-thirds of respondents said that their first position after graduation was either directly or indirectly related to their college majors. Full-time positions were viewed as related to majors, either directly or indirectly, more often than part-time positions (73% FT vs. 50% PT). Seventy percent of respondents viewed their first position either as either a career (14%) or, more commonly, a stepping stone to a career (56%). Compared to full-time positions, part-time positions were much more likely to be described as "just something to get me by for now" (16% FT vs. 59% PT). Most respondents (92%) said that they were either appropriately qualified or over-qualified for their first positions. Over half of students whose first positions after graduation were part-time said they were overqualified for these positions.




Figure 1. Primary activities as reported on the One-Year-Out survey (dark bar) and expected for the next 12 months (light bar).

The survey asked about graduates' expected primary and secondary activities for the next 12 months. Seventy-one percent of respondents said they expected no change in their primary activity, or perhaps change in detail only (e.g., change jobs but remain employed full-time), and 29 percent expected their primary activity category to change (e.g., from full-time employment to a full-time degree program). Figure 1 shows the differences between respondents' primary activities as reported on the survey in mid-2015 and their expected activities for the year ahead. The largest net change was in the percent of respondents whose primary activity will be full-time enrollment in a degree program, which doubled from 10 percent to 20 percent. The percent of respondents whose primary activity will be part-time employment or volunteer activity/service dropped by roughly half.




Figure 2. Primary and secondary activities as reported on the One-Year-Out survey (dark bar) and expected for the next 12 months (light bar).

Figure 2 shows the differences between the activities—primary and secondary—that respondents reported on the survey in mid-2015 and their expected activities for the year ahead. Of note is the increase in the percent of graduates who will be enrolled in a degree program either full-time (up from 12% to 22%) or part-time (up from 3% to 7%). As was the case in the first year after graduation, just over one quarter of respondents said that they expect to be searching for a job, primarily as a secondary activity, in the upcoming year. However, this figure could be inflated if respondents who reported a job search within the past year neglected to also report that they would not be continuing this activity in the year ahead. The survey's question about anticipated change in the next 12 months assumes that all of the primary and secondary activities graduates report at the start of the survey will be repeated in the upcoming year unless a respondent specifically indicates otherwise, which is problematic in the event respondents do not or cannot remember all of the activities they reported earlier in the survey.

The survey asked all graduates to report on the various job search approaches they have used. Results are presented in Table 3. The most commonly used approach was networking, which was also rated highest in terms of usefulness. At least half of respondents said they have used the general LinkedIn website, job aggregator websites, and volunteering/interning when looking for employment. Volunteering/interning received relatively high ratings in terms of its usefulness.

#### SUPPLEMENTING THE ONE-YEAR-OUT SURVEY DATA

Because of the importance of graduates' outcomes and the reality that alumni surveys typically achieve low response rates, we took additional steps to learn more about Class of 2014 graduates. First, we queried the National Student Clearinghouse database to identify graduate school enrollments of the survey nonrespondents. A total of 26 graduates who did not complete the survey were found to be enrolled in educational institutions as of fall 2015. We also searched for nonrespondents on social media websites (most notably, LinkedIn) attempting to document their educational and/or employment activities since graduating. Overall, we located usable information on what appeared to be current activities for 174 more survey nonrespondents. Finally, we asked the CELS office staff to provide any information on the remaining students for whom we were unable to locate information. Through this method, we aimed to produce a snapshot of the graduating class at one moment in time that is as complete and accurate as possible, recognizing that some of the information will become outdated quickly due to the fluidity of young adults' lives in the initial years after college.

Combining the data from all sources (see Table 4), we documented the activities of 401 of the 468 members of the Class of 2014, or 86 percent. This far exceeds what one would hope to achieve from an alumni survey alone, and it exceeds the response rates on which many colleges' published alumni outcomes data are based. Summarizing the outcomes is tricky because many graduates will be engaged in more than one activity. For ease of reporting, each graduate is presented as having a single outcome, although it should be remembered that this somewhat oversimplifies our graduates' actual activities, which may include a variety of significant secondary activities.

Overall, about 76 percent of the Class of 2014 graduates for whom we found outcomes information were employed, and 13 percent were enrolled in a degree program – a total of 89 percent. Another 5 percent had a fellowship or were working in volunteer and service programs such as AmeriCorps VISTA. Together, then, of the graduates for whom we located information, 93 percent were employed, enrolled in a graduate or professional degree program, completing a fellowship, or engaged in public service.

By fall 2015, four Class of 2014 graduates had already earned master's degrees—in Applied Linguistics (M.A., University of Sussex), Art Education (M.A.T., Rhode Island School of Design), Journalism (M.S., Columbia University), and Health Policy and Clinical Practice (M.P.H., Dartmouth College). Additionally, one graduate earned a paralegal certificate from Villanova University.

Details of the degree programs in which Class of 2014 graduates enrolled are presented in Appendix A (sorted by institution) and Appendix B (sorted by major). These tables do not include non-degree coursework, certificate programs, or other enrollments where degree-seeking status was unclear. Appendices C and D present details of graduates' employment, fellowships, internships, and volunteer service by employer and major, respectively. For One-Year-Out Survey respondents, only details for the most recent position as entered by graduates on the survey are shown. Note that this information may not reflect graduates' *current* positions, nor does it necessarily correspond to graduates' primary activity. For survey nonrespondents, details reflect graduates' most recent known experience.
